*All dressage tests will be in a 20 X 40 ring.

All riders, Junior and Senior, are required to wear approved headgear while riding anywhere on the grounds, including the Dressage test. Approved protective headgear complying with European (EN), British (PAS), North American (ASTM), and Australian/New Zealand tested standards is compulsory.

Cross Country Phase:

All riders are required to wear a **certified protective vest** during the Cross Country jumping phase. You will not be able to compete without a vest.

This is a schooling show and is designed to give competitors every opportunity for success.

There will be no eliminations during the cross-country phase unless there is a fall and/or it is deemed unsafe for the rider and horse to continue. All riders must be checked out before remounting after any fall, during competition or warm-up.

There will be 20 faults given for each refusal. If a competitor is not successful after their 3rd attempt, they will proceed to the next obstacle. An additional 100 faults will be added for non-completion of a jump. All divisions in the cross-country phase will be timed. There will be 0.4 penalties for each second over optimum time or if 30 seconds or more under the optimum time for XC.

Show Jumping Phase:

4 faults for each rail, 4 faults for first disobedience, 8 faults for second refusal. Elimination after 3rd.

0.4 penalties for each second over optimum time.

All divisions in the show jumping phase will be timed.

* **NOTE:** The Organizing Committee reserves the right to dismiss a rider from the competition if considered unsafe or if the health and safety of the horse is compromised.
